- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 50-29-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to eligibility under the state children's health insurance program.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 50-29-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
  amended and reenacted as follows:
  50-29-04. Plan requirements. The plan:
  Must be provided through private contracts with insurance carriers:
- 7 1. Must be provided through private contracts with insurance carriers;
  - Must allow conversion to another health insurance policy;
- 9 3. Must be based on an actuarial equivalent of a benchmark plan;
- 4. Must incorporate every state-required waiver approved by the federal government;
