SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4032

- 1 A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to article III of the Constitution of
- 2 North Dakota, relating to vote requirements for local ordinances or initiated laws imposing
- 3 requirements for supermajority votes; and to provide an effective date.

4 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 5 This measure provides that if the electorate proposes an initiated measure or if a political
- 6 subdivision governing body attempts to pass an ordinance that would impose a requirement of
- 7 a supermajority vote, the electors must approve that measure or ordinance by at least that
- 8 supermajority amount.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF

10 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 11 That the following proposed new section to article III of the Constitution of North Dakota
- 12 is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general
- 13 election to be held in 2010, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of
- 14 North Dakota.

- 15 **SECTION 1.** A new section to article III of the Constitution of North Dakota is created
- 16 and enacted as follows:
- 17 If the electors of the state propose to initiate a law, ordinance, or resolution or the
- 18 governing body of a political subdivision adopts an ordinance or resolution that would require a
- 19 vote of more than a simple majority of the electors to approve a ballot measure, the measure,
- 20 ordinance, or resolution may become effective only if approved by at least the same
- 21 percentage of the vote of the electors as is required by that measure, ordinance, or resolution.
- 22 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** If approved by voters, this measure becomes
- 23 effective on January 1, 2011.
