- 1 A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to article IV of the Constitution of
- 2 North Dakota, relating to the submission of laws to the electorate for approval.

3 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 4 This measure authorizes the legislative assembly to submit laws to the electorate for approval.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
- 6 **SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**
 - That the following proposed new section to article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general election to be held in 2010, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota.
 - **SECTION 1.** A new section to article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota is created and enacted as follows:
 - Notwithstanding section 1 of article III, the legislative assembly may submit laws to the electorate for approval. A statutory measure approved by a majority of votes cast is deemed enacted and becomes effective thirty days after the election or on a later date specified in the measure, and a statutory measure that is rejected is void immediately. A statutory measure approved by the electors may not be repealed or amended by the legislative assembly for
- 18 <u>seven years from its effective date, except by a two-thirds vote of the members elected to each</u>
- 19 house.
