4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 43-30-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 1. Any investigator or officer directly employed by or under any direct contract with the federal government, state, or any county or city thereof, appointed, elected, or contracted with, by due authority of law, while engaged in the performance of official duties. Subcontractors of agencies directly contracted with these entities are not exempted. A licensed peace officer or auxiliary officer employed by a law enforcement agency may not work as a security officer unless:
 - a. The officer's law enforcement agency has been contracted to provide security
 with all remunerations paid directly to that agency; or
 - b. The officer is employed by a private security service licensed under this
 chapter and the officer is registered as required by this chapter.
