- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 15.1-21-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a high school course in consumer finance.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 15.1-21-02 of the North Dakota

- 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- In order to be approved by the superintendent of public instruction, each public and
   nonpublic high school shall make available to each student:
- 8 a. Four units of English language arts;
- 9 b. Four units of mathematics;
- 10 c. Four units of science;
- 11 d. Four units of social studies, including one of world history and one of United
  12 States history;
- e. One-half unit of health;
- 14f.One-half unit of physical education during each school year, provided that15once every four years the unit must be a concept-based fitness class that16includes instruction in the assessment, improvement, and maintenance of17personal fitness;
- 18 g. Two units of fine arts, at least one of which must be music;
- 19 h. Two units of the same foreign language; and
- 20 i. <u>One-half unit of consumer finance; and</u>
- 21 <u>j.</u> Two units of career and technical education.
