4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 57-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Sexually oriented business - Registration - Penalty.

A person that operates a sexually oriented business or who performs live nude entertainment for a sexually oriented business shall register annually with the tax commissioner. The tax commissioner shall provide registration forms and guidelines for registration under this section and shall issue a registration certificate to each person registered. A registration certificate issued to an individual providing live nude entertainment must include the individual's name and the name and business address of any sexually oriented business with which the individual is associated. A sexually oriented business required to register under this section shall include in its registration the permanent business address of the business and shall inform the tax commissioner of any change in the business address within fourteen days of the change. Each person required to register under this section shall keep detailed records listing all taxable income earned by that entity related to providing live nude entertainment. An individual providing live nude entertainment shall have the detailed record and the individual's registration certificate in that individual's possession at any time the individual is providing live nude entertainment.

- 2. For the purposes of this section, "sexually oriented business" means an individual or a commercial enterprise that advertises, offers, or provides live nude entertainment for a fee or in connection with any other transfer of money. "Nude" means entirely unclothed or clothed in a manner that leaves uncovered or visible through less than fully opaque clothing any portion of the breasts below the top of the areola of the breasts, if the individual is female, or any portion of the genitals or buttocks.
 - 3. Any person violating this section is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
