BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-01.3 of the North Dakota Century Code
 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **20.1-03-01.3. Exemptions.** Sections 20.1-03-01.1 through 20.1-03-01.3 and 9 20.1-03-01.2 do not apply to:
- 10 1. Persons Individuals under twelve years of age who hunt only with their parent or legal guardian.
- Persons Individuals who hunt exclusively on land of which they are the record title
 owner or operator.
- 14 3. Individuals who possess an apprentice hunter validation issued under section 2 of
 this Act.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - Apprentice hunter validation. An individual born after December 31, 1961, who is sixteen years of age or older and who does not possess a hunter safety education course certificate of completion may be issued an apprentice hunter validation. An apprentice hunter validation is valid for only one license year in a lifetime. An individual in possession of an apprentice hunter validation may hunt small game and deer only when accompanied by an
- 23 adult licensed to hunt in this state whose license was not obtained using an apprentice hunter
- 24 <u>validation</u>. An apprentice hunter validation holder must obtain all required licenses and stamps.

- 1 For purposes of this section, "accompanied" means to stay within a distance of another
- 2 individual that permits uninterrupted visual contact in unaided verbal communication.
- 3 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
