5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-20-12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code 7 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **12.1-20-12.1.** Indecent exposure.
- A person, with intent to arouse, appeal to, or gratify that person's lust, passions, or 10 sexual desires, is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if that person:
 - Masturbates in a public place or in the presence of a minor; or a.
 - b. Exposes one's penis, vulva, or anus in a public place or to a minor in a public or private place.
 - A person is guilty of a class C felony if the person violates subsection 1 after a 2. previous conviction for violating subsection 1, after a previous conviction for violating section 12.1-20-12.2, or after being required to register under section 12.1-32-15.
 - A person who commits a violation of subsection 1 within fifty feet [15.24 meters] of or on the real property comprising a public or nonpublic elementary, middle, or high school is guilty of a class C felony. A person who commits a violation of subsection 2 within fifty feet [15.24 meters] of or on the real property comprising a public or nonpublic elementary, middle, or high school is guilty of a class B felony.
 - The act of a woman discreetly breastfeeding her child is not a violation of this section.

3	Right to breastfeed. If the woman acts in a discreet and modest manner, a woman		
4	may breastfeed her child in any location, public or private, where the woman and child are

6	Workplace breastfeeding policies - Infant friendly designation.		
7	<u>1.</u>	<u>An e</u>	employer may use the designation "infant friendly" on its promotional materials
8		if the	e employer adopts a workplace breastfeeding policy that includes the following
9		<u>a.</u>	Flexible work scheduling, including scheduling breaks and permitting work
10			patterns that provide time for expression of breast milk;
11		<u>b.</u>	A convenient, sanitary, safe, and private location, other than a restroom,
12			allowing privacy for breastfeeding or expressing breast milk;
13		<u>c.</u>	A convenient clean and safe water source with facilities for washing hands
14			and rinsing breast-pumping equipment located in the private location
15			specified in subdivision b; and
16		<u>d.</u>	A convenient hygienic refrigerator in the workplace for the temporary storage
17			of the mother's breast milk.
18	<u>2.</u>	The	state department of health shall establish guidelines for employers concerning
19		worl	xplace breastfeeding and infant friendly designations.
