- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 12.1-17-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the killing or injury of a law enforcement support animal; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-17-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 12.1-17-09. Killing or injury of certified, law enforcement support dog animal Definition Penalty.
- 8 A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor C felony and is subject to a civil 1. 9 penalty of up to ten thousand dollars if that person willfully and unjustifiably kills, 10 shoots, tortures, torments, beats, kicks, strikes, mutilates, disables, or otherwise 11 injures a certified, law enforcement support dog animal. 12 A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor and is subject to a civil penalty of up 2. 13 to five thousand dollars if that person willfully: 14 Harasses, taunts, or provokes a law enforcement support animal; a. 15 b. Interferes with a law enforcement support animal while the animal is working; 16 or 17 c. Interferes with the individual handling the animal. 18 For purposes of this section, "certified, law enforcement support dog animal" 3. 19 means any dog animal used by or on behalf of a law enforcement officer in the 20 performance of the officer's functions and duties, including crowd control,
- 21 <u>corrections, arson investigation, or search and rescue,</u> regardless of whether the 22 dog <u>animal</u> is on or off duty.

- 1 <u>4.</u> This section does not apply to a law enforcement officer or a veterinarian who
- 2 terminates the life of a certified, law enforcement support dog <u>animal</u> to relieve the
- 3 dog <u>animal</u> of undue suffering and pain.
