4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. Board of higher education - Low-income student assistance grants.

- 1. To increase the likelihood that the students will graduate from either a two-year or a four-year institution of higher education, the state board of higher education may provide grants to any institution of higher education for the purpose of offering support to students from low-income families and specifically to those students who are the first members of their families to attend an institution of higher education.
- 12 2. For purposes of this section, "support" includes:
- a. Tutoring;
- 14 <u>b. Personal, financial, and academic counseling;</u>
- 15 <u>c. Mentoring;</u>
- d. Cultural enrichment; and
- 17 <u>e. The provision of work study opportunities.</u>
- Any institution receiving a grant under this section shall file a report with the
 legislative council detailing the program of support and its outcome.
- SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much
 of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of
 providing grants to institutions of higher education that support the retention of students from

low-income families, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
