- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 11-23-01, 50-06-20, 50-09-27, and 57-15-31
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to programs funded at state expense and county
- 3 property tax levies; to repeal section 50-09-21.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
- 4 foster care and subsidized adoption services; and to provide an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 11-23-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

11-23-01. Officers required to furnish commissioners with departmental budget.

- 1. Every officer in charge of any institution, office, or undertaking supported wholly or in part by the county shall file with the board of county commissioners a departmental budget that is prescribed by the state auditor. The departmental budget must include an itemized statement of the estimated amount of money that will be required for the maintenance, operation, or improvement of the institution, office, or undertaking for the ensuing year. The board of county commissioners may require additional information to clarify the departmental budget.
- 2. The departmental budget submitted annually by the county social service board must identify the reduction in county funding derived from transferring foster care and subsidized adoption costs pursuant to provisions of this Act from the county social service board to the department of human services beginning August 1, 2009. The amount reported must equal the full amount budgeted for these costs in the budget submitted by the county social service board and approved by the board of county commissioners in the previous year. Each county social service board shall report the county funding reduction required by this subsection to the department of human services by December thirty-first of each year.

7	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 57-15-31 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
8	amended and reenacted as follows:			
9	57-15-31. Determination of levy. The amount to be levied by any county, city,			
10	township, school district, park district, or other municipality authorized to levy taxes shall be			
11	computed by deducting from the amount of estimated expenditures for the current fiscal year as			
12	finally determined, plus the required reserve fund determined upon by the governing board from			
13	the past experience of the taxing district, the total of the following items:			
14	1.	The available surplus consisting of the free and unencumbered cash balance.		
15	2.	Estimated revenues from sources other than direct property taxes.		
16	3.	The total estimated collections from tax levies for previous years.		
17	4.	Such expenditures as are to be made from bond sources.		
18	5.	The amount of distributions received from an economic growth increment pool		
19		under section 57-15-61.		
20	6.	The estimated amount to be received from payments in lieu of taxes on a project		
21		under section 40-57.1-03.		
22	<u>7.</u>	The amount reported by a county under subsection 2 of section 11-23-01 relating		
23		to foster care and subsidized adoption costs paid by the state beginning August 1,		
24		<u>2009.</u>		
25	Allowance may be made for a permanent delinquency or loss in tax collection not to exceed			
26	five percent of the amount of the levy.			
27	SECTION 5. REPEAL. Section 50-09-21.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
28	repealed.			
29	SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 4 of this Act is effective for taxable years			
30	beginning after December 31, 2008.
