- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a study by the adjutant general of the effects of next generation
- 2 911; and to provide an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. STUDY NEXT GENERATION 911.** During the 2009-10 interim, the
- 5 adjutant general shall study the effects of next generation 911 on the public safety answering
- 6 points in the state. The study must address the technology needs relating to next generation
- 7 911, the most efficient method of implementing next generation 911, including the use of shared
- 8 technology, and any necessary changes to the current 911 funding model. Before July 1, 2010,
- 9 the adjutant general shall report the outcomes and recommendations of this study to the
- 10 legislative council.

- 11 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 12 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much
- 13 of the sum as may be necessary, to the adjutant general for the purpose of conducting the
- 14 study required in section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending
- 15 June 30, 2011.
