- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-21-02.2 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to high school coursework requirements.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-21-02.2 of the North Dakota Century Code 5 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-21-02.2. High school coursework requirements.
 - Beginning with the 2008-09 school year, no A student may not graduate from a
 high school in this state unless the student demonstrates successful completion of
 the following:
 - a. Four units of English language arts;
 - b. Two units of mathematics;
- 12 c. Two units of science;
- d. Three units of social studies, which may include one-half unit of North Dakota
 studies and one-half unit of multicultural studies;
- e. One unit of physical education, which may include up to one half;
- f. One-half unit of health; and
- f. g. One unit of a foreign or native American language, fine arts, or career and technical education.
 - The superintendent of public instruction shall work with each school district to identify course offerings that meet the requirements of subdivisions a through f of subsection 1.
- Before September first of each year, each school district shall file a copy of its
 graduation requirements with the superintendent of public instruction.

- 1 4. A school district may not reduce its graduation requirements below those in
- 2 existence on June 30, 2007.
