- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to guide and outfitter license exemptions.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 20.1-03-36.1 of the North Dakota
Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 4. A Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a license is not required for a 7 person to provide services on real property that person owns or leases for the 8 primary pursuit of bona fide agricultural interests or for a nonprofit organization 9 registered with the secretary of state. However, a person that owns or leases real 10 property for the primary pursuit of bona fide agricultural interests that commits an 11 act or engages in conduct that would result in the denial, revocation, or suspension 12 of a license otherwise issued under this chapter if the landowner were not a 13 landowner is not exempt from licensure. The director shall determine the number of 14 acres by county exempted from licensure by this subsection and shall publish the 15 results. The director shall provide written information to the public on the possible 16 liability exposure for outfitting under this subsection and on the benefits of liability 17 insurance and proper training.
