- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to guide and outfitter license exemptions.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 20.1-03-36.1 of the North Dakota
Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 4. A Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a license is not required for a 7 person to provide services on real property that person owns or leases for the 8 primary pursuit of bona fide agricultural interests or for a nonprofit organization registered with the secretary of state. However, a person who has been convicted 9 10 of a state or federal criminal game or fish violation within the last three years or 11 whose license to hunt or fish is under suspension or revocation is not exempt from 12 licensure and is subject to subsection 5 of section 20.1-03-37. The director shall 13 determine the number of acres by county exempted from licensure by this 14 subsection and shall publish the results. The director shall provide written 15 information to the public on the possible liability exposure for outfitting under this 16 subsection and on the benefits of liability insurance and proper training.
