1 A BILL for an Act to provide student loan principal reductions; and to provide an appropriation.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

3	SECTION 1. Student loan principal reductions - Advisory board.
4	 The Bank of North Dakota shall reduce, on a percentage basis, t

- The Bank of North Dakota shall reduce, on a percentage basis, the student loan principal of any individual who graduated from an institution of higher education within the preceding ten-year period and who is and has been a resident of this state for the past twelve months. A reduction under this section is applicable to any student loan, regardless of the originating financial institution.
- 2. To receive the reduction provided for in subsection 1, an individual must request an application from the Bank of North Dakota and return the completed application no later than October 1, 2009, for reductions to be made during 2009 and no later than October 1, 2010, for reductions to be made during 2010.
- 3. A five-member board shall advise the Bank of North Dakota in matters pertaining to the administration of this section. The board consists of:
 - a. The commissioner of commerce, or the commissioner's designee;
 - b. One individual selected by the North Dakota bankers association;
 - c. One individual selected by the North Dakota chamber of commerce;
- d. One individual selected by the executive board of the North Dakota student association; and
 - e. One member of the legislative assembly appointed by the legislative council.

14	providing studen	t loan	principal reductions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending	
15	June 30, 2011.	The Ba	ank of North Dakota may use no more than fifty percent of the amount	
16	appropriated for	studer	nt loan principal reductions during the first year of the biennium.
