- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12-44.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to allowing correctional officers to carry weapons in certain
- 3 circumstances; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:

- 7 Correctional officers authorized to carry weapons. The administrator of a
- 8 correctional facility may allow a qualified correctional officer to carry a weapon, including a
- 9 firearm, during the transport of another governmental agency's prisoner if the correctional
- 10 <u>facility has a contract with the governmental agency to transport the agency's prisoners and</u>
- 11 that contract requires the officer doing the transport to be armed with a weapon. For purposes
- 12 of this section, "governmental agency" means an agency or department of this state or of any
- 13 political subdivision in this state, or another state or of a political subdivision of another state, or
- 14 of the United States. The administrator of a correctional facility shall adopt a policy, approved
- 15 by the attorney general, which establishes the qualifications and training an officer must meet
- 16 to carry a weapon under this section. Sections 62.1-02-05, 62.1-02-10, and 62.1-03-01 do not
- 17 apply to the possession and use of a firearm by a qualified correctional officer acting in the
- 18 course of employment as allowed by this section.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
