1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 8 of section 44-04-17.1 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to the definition of a meeting.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 8 of section 44-04-17.1 of the North Dakota  
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 8. a. "Meeting" means a formal or informal gathering or a work session, whether in  
7 person or through electronic means such as telephone or videoconference, of:

8 (1) A quorum of the members of the governing body of a public entity  
9 regarding public business; or

10 (2) Less than a quorum of the members of the governing body of a public  
11 entity regarding public business, if the members attending one or more  
12 of such smaller gatherings collectively constitute a quorum and if the  
13 members hold the gathering for the purpose of avoiding the  
14 requirements of section 44-04-19.

15 b. "Meeting" ~~includes work sessions, but~~ does not include:

16 (1) A chance or social gathering where gathering of a quorum of the  
17 members of a governing body at which public business is not  
18 considered ~~and does not include the;~~

19 (2) A chance or social gathering of less than a quorum of the members of a  
20 governing body at which public business is discussed, but no final  
21 action or vote is taken; and

22 (3) The attendance of members of a governing body at meetings of any  
23 national, regional, or state association to which the public entity, the  
24 governing body, or individual members belong.
