- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-01-17 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to posting of lands to prohibit hunting; and to provide a penalty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-01-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 20.1-01-17. Posting of lands by owner or tenant to prohibit hunting How posted
 - Signs defaced. Only the owner or tenant an individual authorized by the owner of any land
- 8 may post it the land by placing signs alongside the public highway or the land giving notice that
- 9 no hunting is not permitted on the land. The name of the person posting the land must appear
- 10 on each sign in legible characters. The signs must be readable from the outside of the land and
- must be placed conspicuously not more than eight hundred eighty yards [804.68 meters] apart.
- 12 As to land entirely enclosed by a fence or other enclosure, posting of signs at or on all gates
- 13 through the fence or enclosure constitutes a posting of all the enclosed land. If the posting of
- 14 the land varies from the provisions of this section, an individual may be found guilty of violating
- 15 section 20.1-01-18 if there is substantial compliance with this section and the intention of the
- 16 owner or individual authorized by the owner to post the land is clear from the circumstances. No
- 17 A person may in any manner not deface, take down, or destroy posting signs, or post property
- 18 without the permission of the owner or individual authorized by the owner.
