- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to game and fish license fees for residents under eighteen years of age;
- 3 and to amend and reenact subsections 1 and 3 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota
- 4 Century Code, relating to game and fish license fees.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsections 1 and 3 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North
- 7 Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 1. For a resident, age <u>sixteen</u> <u>eighteen</u> and over, small game hunting license, six dollars.
 - For a resident big game hunting license, twenty dollars, except the fee for a
 licensee under age sixteen is ten dollars, except as provided in a gubernatorial
 proclamation issued pursuant to section 20.1-08-04.1.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- No license fee for residents under age eighteen Authority to increase fees.
- 16 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the director may not charge a game or fish license
- 17 fee for a license issued to a resident under eighteen years of age. Notwithstanding game and
- 18 fish license fees established by statute, the director by rule may increase game and fish license
- 19 fees to offset the revenue lost by not charging game or fish license fees for licenses issued to
- 20 residents under eighteen years of age.
