- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 3 and 6 of section 61-04-01.1 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the definitions of domestic use and irrigation use.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsections 3 and 6 of section 61-04-01.1 of the North
 Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 3. "Domestic use" means the use of water by an individual, or by a family unit, or 7 household, for personal needs and for household purposes, including, but not 8 limited to heating, drinking, washing, sanitary, and culinary uses; irrigation of land 9 not exceeding one acre [.40 hectare] five acres [2.0 hectares] in area for 10 noncommercial gardens, orchards, lawns, trees, or shrubbery; and for household 11 pets and domestic animals kept for household sustenance and not for sale or 12 commercial use, when the water is supplied by the individual or family unit. Also 13 included within this use are "domestic rural uses" which must be defined by the 14 state engineer by rule.
- "Irrigation use" means the use of water for application to more than one acre
 [-40 hectare] five acres [2.0 hectares] of land to stimulate the growth of agricultural
 crops, including gardens, orchards, lawns, trees, or shrubbery, or the maintenance
 of recreation areas such as athletic fields, golf courses, parks, and similar types of
 areas, except when the water for the facility is provided by a municipal water
 system.
