3	BE IT ENA	CTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
4	SEC	CTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 47-19-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5	amended and reenacted as follows:	
6	47-1	19-02. Instruments entitled to record without acknowledgment. The following
7	instruments	may be recorded without acknowledgment or further proof:
8	<del>1.</del>	Any judgment affecting the title to or the possession of real property authenticated
9		by the certificate of the clerk of the court in which such judgment is rendered.
10	<del>2.</del>	Any letters patent from the United States.
11	<del>3.</del>	Any duplicate final register's receipt.
12	4.	A certificate from the United States land office.
13	<del>5.</del>	A contract between the state and a purchaser of school and institutional lands for
14		the purchase and sale of such lands.
15	<del>6.</del>	An assignment of any such contract when such assignment has been approved by
16		the board of university and school lands.
17	<del>7.</del>	Any certified copy of a patent or of a duplicate final register's receipt or certificate
18		when certified and proved according to the laws of the United States and of this
19		state in such manner as to entitle it to admission as evidence in the courts of this
20		state, and when so recorded, it shall be notice in like manner and to the same
21		extent as the originals thereof would have been if the same had been recorded.

A certified copy of an order of a district court relating to estate tax determinations.

A statement of the state tax commissioner relating to estate tax determination.

Any affidavit made as is provided in section 47-19-12.

An instrument includes 9 a contract or agreement that is entered by one of these governmental entities that 10 contract or agreement is deemed to have been issued by the entity. An instrument certified by an agency, bureau, department, or the judiciary of the 11 <u>2.</u> United States or a foreign government, a state of the United States or a political 12 13 subdivision of a state, or an Indian tribe recognized by the United States 14 department of the interior. 15 A lis pendens or other instrument that is signed by an attorney at law licensed to 3. 16 practice law in this state which bears the attorney's identification number issued by 17 the state board of law examiners.
