**SENATE BILL NO. 2329**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide for an appropriation to the industrial commission for creating  
2 geographic information system-based maps or overlays; and to provide an appropriation to the  
3 state historical society for the purpose of coordinating the mapping project.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION.** There is appropriated  
6 out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum  
7 of \$290,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the industrial commission for the  
8 purpose of identifying historical trails and creating geographic information system-based maps  
9 or overlays of these trails for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.  
10 The industrial commission is authorized 2 full-time equivalent positions only for the biennium  
11 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

12 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY.** There is  
13 appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise  
14 appropriated, the sum of \$290,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state  
15 historical society for the purpose of coordinating the mapping project provided for in section 1 of  
16 this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The state  
17 historical society is authorized 2 full-time equivalent positions only for the biennium beginning  
18 July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

19 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** Any other funds received by the industrial  
20 commission from federal or other sources for the mapping project, in addition to the funds  
21 appropriated in section 1 of this Act, are appropriated to the industrial commission for the  
22 project, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

23 **SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION.** Any other funds received by the historical society  
24 from federal or other sources for the mapping project, in addition to the funds appropriated in

- 1 section 2 of this Act, are appropriated to the state historical society for the project, for the
- 2 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
