- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-39.4-31 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to membership of the streamlined sales tax governing board.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-39.4-31 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

57-39.4-31. Membership of streamlined sales tax governing board and state and local advisory council.

- 1. Two members One member of the house of representatives and two members one member of the senate, each selected from the majority party of the member's chamber, to be appointed by the chairman of the legislative council, and the tax commissioner or the tax commissioner's designee shall represent the state of North Dakota on the streamlined sales tax governing board. In addition, if the member from the house of representatives and the member from the senate are members of the same political party, one member of the minority party from either the house of representatives or the senate must be appointed by the chairman of the legislative council and shall represent the state of North Dakota on the streamlined sales tax governing board.
- One member of the house of representatives and one member of the senate, to be appointed by the chairman of the legislative council, shall represent the state of North Dakota on the streamlined sales tax state and local advisory council.
- 3. The tax commissioner shall designate a member of the tax commissioner's staff to accompany and advise the members appointed under this section with regard to multistate discussions to review or revise the agreement or to conduct such other business as comes before the board or council.
