1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 4-10.6 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code or in the alternative to create and enact section 4.1-04-04.1 of the North Dakota

3 Century Code, relating to corn utilization council elections; and to amend and reenact sections

4 4-10.6-02 and 4-10.6-08 of the North Dakota Century Code or in the alternative to amend and

5 reenact sections 4.1-04-04 and 4.1-04-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to corn

6 assessments.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-10.6-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 9 amended and reenacted as follows:

10 **4-10.6-02.** North Dakota corn utilization council - Members - Election - Term.

- 11 The North Dakota corn utilization council must be composed of one member 1. 12 elected from each district established by section 4-10.6-03. The chairman of the 13 council must be a member of the council elected by a majority vote of the council. 14 Each member must be a resident of and participating grower in the district the 15 member represents. The term of each member is four years, beginning on April 16 first of the year of election, except that initially three members must be elected for 17 four-year terms; two members must be elected for three-year terms; and two 18 members must be elected for two-year terms as designated by the commissioner. 19 If at any time during a member's term the member ceases to possess any of the 20 gualifications required by this chapter, the member's office is deemed vacant and 21 the council shall appoint a qualified participating grower from any district to 22 complete the term of office.
- 23 <u>2.</u> The council shall administer <u>conduct</u> all elections and may request the assistance
 24 of the commissioner. Elections must be conducted no later than April first of each

11			newspaper of the county for two consecutive weeks. The last notice must be

14		<u>d.</u>	During the meeting, the county extension agent shall conduct the election.		
15		<u>e.</u>	Any producer who resides in the county and who did not request a refund		
16			during the preceding year may vote in the election.		
17		<u>f.</u>	The county extension agent shall canvass the votes, notify the director of the		
18			North Dakota state university extension service and the council that the		
19			election has taken place, and provide to the director and the council the name		
20			and address of the newly elected county representative.

	call a meeting of all county representatives in the district represented by the

<u>2.</u>	The director shall notify each county representative in the district of the meeting, by			
	registered mail, at least five days before the meeting.			
<u>3.</u>	The meeting must be held within the district.			
<u>4.</u>	At the meeting, the county representatives shall elect one from among themselves			
	to serve as the council member from that district.			
<u>5.</u>	The director shall notify the governor and the council that the election has taken			
	place and shall provide to the governor and the council the name and address of			
	the newly elected council member.

amended a	nd reenacted as follows:			
4-10	0.6-08. Assessment. Effective July 1, 1991 Until the commissioner certifies that a			
national co	rn checkoff is in effect, an assessment at the rate of one-quarter of one percent of			
3 the value of a bushel must be levied and imposed upon all corn marketed grown in this state ,				
until a natic	nal corn checkoff is implemented. This assessment is due upon any identifiable lot			
or quantity of corn.				
SEC	CTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-04-04 of the North Dakota Century Code as			
created by	House Bill No. 1025, as approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly, is amended			
and reenacted as follows:				
4.1-	04-04. Election of council member county representative.			
1.	a. No later than January March first of the year in which the term of a council			
	member is to expire, the council shall appoint an nominating committee			
	consisting of at least two producers who reside in the council member's			
	district and who have not requested a refund under section 4.1-04-13 during			
	the preceding year.			
2.	No later than February first, the committee shall nominate a qualified producer as a			
	candidate for council membership.

1	3.	Other qualified producers may become candidates for council membership by
2		submitting to the council, no later than March first, a petition signed by at least five
3		producers who reside in the district to be represented.
4	4.	-a. If a qualified producer submits a petition in accordance with subsection 3, the
5		council shall:
6		(1) Determine the date, time, and place for the election;
7		(2) Publish that information in the official newspaper of each county in the
8		district for two consecutive weeks;
9		(3) Prepare the ballots; and
10		(4) Conduct the election.
11		b. If a qualified producer does not submit a petition in accordance with
12		subsection 3, and the only candidate for council membership is the individual
13		recommended by the nominating committee, the council shall waive the
14		election requirements and declare that the individual recommended by the
15		nominating committee is the new council member.
16	5.	Any producer who resides in the district and who did not request a refund under
17		section 4.1-04-13 during the preceding year may vote in the election.
18	6.	The council shall provide to the governor the name and address of the new council
19		member extension agent for each county in that member's district shall hold a
20		meeting of corn producers for the purpose of electing a county representative.
21		b. The county extension agent shall publish notice of the meeting in the official
22		newspaper of the county for two consecutive weeks. The last notice must be
23		published no fewer than five nor more than ten days before the meeting.

24	is in effect, an assessment at the rate of one-quarter of one percent of the value of a bushel					
25	must be imposed upon all corn grown and sold in this state.
