| 17 | SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 54-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is |

| 19 | Youth council duties. The North Dakota youth council shall develop a list of issues |
| 20 | and concerns pertinent to residents of this state who have not yet reached the age of |
| 21 | twenty-five. The list may include education, health care, employment opportunities, and quality |
| 22 | of life issues such as recreation and entertainment. The council, on its own and in conjunction |
| 23 | with any guests it elects to invite, shall explore its issues and concerns, review current |
| 24 | situations, and develop recommendations for consideration by local, regional, and state-level |
| 25 | policymakers. The council shall provide a report and any recommendations to the legislative |
| 26 | council before September 1, 2010. |
| 27 | SECTION 5. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through June 30, 2011, and |
| 28 | after that date is ineffective. |
