- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 1 and 3 of section 15-10-37 and section
- 2 15-62.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to student financial assistance grants
- 3 and technology grants; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsections 1 and 3 of section 15-10-37 of the North Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:
 - The state board of higher education shall administer a <u>science</u>, technology, <u>engineering</u>, and <u>mathematics</u> occupations student loan program that encourages college students to pursue technology based studies <u>in these fields</u>, to participate in technology internship programs, and to remain in the state after graduation. The board shall adopt rules to implement the program, including internship requirements, guidelines to determine which technology-related courses of study are eligible under the program, and standards for eligibility.
 - 3. The state board of higher education shall distribute student loan grants directly to the Bank of North Dakota to repay outstanding student loan principal balances for eligible applicants. The maximum student loan grant amount for which an applicant may qualify is one two thousand dollars per year and a total of five ten thousand dollars, or a lesser amount established by rule adopted by the state board of higher education.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15-62.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 23 <u>1.</u> The state board of higher education shall:

Administer the North Dakota student financial assistance program and the a. 2 North Dakota scholars program and adopt functional rules regarding the 3 eligibility and selection of grant and scholarship recipients. 4 2. b. Determine the amount of individual grants, but which may not to exceed one 5 two thousand dollars per recipient per academic year, under the North Dakota 6 student financial assistance program. 7 3. Adopt for For the North Dakota student financial assistance program, adopt C. 8 criteria for substantial need, based upon the ability of the parents or quardian 9 to contribute toward the applicant's educational expenses. In determining 10 educational expenses for an applicant attending an institution of higher 11 education other than an institution under the control of the state board of 12 higher education, the board shall use the lesser of: 13 (1) The statewide average tuition charged that year at four-year institutions 14 of higher education under the control of the state board of higher 15 education; or 16 (2)The actual tuition charged that year by the institution in which the 17 applicant is enrolled. 18 4. Establish the appropriate procedures for fiscal control, fund accounting, and d. 19 necessary reports. 20 5. Apply for, receive, expend, and administer granted moneys from federal or 21 private sources. 22 The state board of higher education may not expend in excess of forty million 2. 23 dollars for student financial assistance grants during the 2009-11 biennium. 24 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** Section 2 of this Act is declared to be an emergency 25 measure.
