- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 5 of section 49-22-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- a. Generation of one hundred thousand kilowatts or more exceeding sixty
 megawatts of electricity;

OTHER NATURAL RESOURCES. During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall study the development of wind resources and other natural resources in the same location. The study must include a review of laws relating to the siting and decommissioning of wind energy conversion facilities, the desirability of an environmental assessment as a condition of siting, and the desirability of regulation to address the effects of wind energy conversion facilities on water, soil, cultural resources, and future development of other natural resources. The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative
