- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-21.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to energy conservation standards for new buildings.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-21.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 54-21.2-03. Energy conservation standards. The standards for energy conservation
 in new building construction, for thermal design conditions and criteria for buildings, and for
- 8 adequate thermal resistance in regard to the design and selection of mechanical, electrical
- 9 service, and illumination systems and equipment which will enable the effective use of energy in
- 10 new buildings, must at least equal the Energy Conservation Code based on the Council of
- 11 American Building Officials Model Energy Code, 1989 Edition. The department of commerce
- 12 shall adopt rules to implement, update, and amend the Model Energy Code be consistent with
- 13 the state building code.
