1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-21.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to energy conservation standards for new buildings.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-21.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 54-21.2-03. Energy conservation standards. The standards Standards for energy 7 conservation in new building construction, for thermal design conditions and criteria for 8 buildings, and for adequate thermal resistance in regard to the design and selection of mechanical, electrical service, and illumination systems and equipment which will enable the 9 10 effective use of energy in new buildings, must at least equal the Energy Conservation Code 11 based on the Council of American Building Officials Model Energy Code, 1989 Edition. The 12 department of commerce shall adopt rules to implement, update, and amend the Model Energy 13 Code be included in the state building code.
