- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 39-13-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the installation of tourist-oriented directional signs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 39-13-09 of the North Dakota
Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 4. The permit applicant shall engage a qualified contractor or the department for the 7 erection, installation, and maintenance of tourist-oriented directional signs within 8 the right of way of any highway under the jurisdiction of the department except that 9 tourist-oriented directional signs may not be erected within the right of way of the 10 interstate highway system. A tourist-oriented directional sign may not be erected 11 unless it is erected in compliance with rules adopted by the department for such 12 signs. If the department erects, installs, or maintains a sign, the department may 13 charge the applicant the costs incurred by the department and may collect the 14 charged costs under a payment plan.
