- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for an interim select committee on the status of health care; to
- 2 provide for a report to the legislative council; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. SELECT COMMITTEE ON THE STATUS OF HEALTH CARE - REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

- 1. During the 2009-10 interim, the state department of health shall establish and provide administrative services for the select committee on the status of health care. The committee shall hold meetings across the state and shall prepare a final report and recommendations that must be presented to the governor and must be presented to the legislative council at the 2010 biennial meeting at which interim committees present final reports.
- 2. The committee shall study the statewide health care delivery infrastructure in this state, including the following health care provider network:
 - a. Hospitals:
 - (1) Classifications; and
 - (2) Geographical access.

 2 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
 3 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much
 4 of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of
 5 conducting the committee charges under section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning
- 6 July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
