## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION AND STATE BOARD
- 5 OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO STUDY IMPLEMENTATION OF INDIAN TREATY RIGHTS
- 6 **RELATING TO EDUCATION.** The superintendent of public instruction and the state board of
- 7 higher education shall conduct a study of the implementation of Indian treaty rights relating to
- 8 education. The superintendent of public instruction shall serve as lead entity for this study and
- 9 report the findings and recommendations of the study to the legislative council by September 1,
- 10 2010.

- 11 SECTION 2. STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO STUDY IMPLEMENTATION OF
- 12 INDIAN TREATY RIGHTS RELATING TO HEALTH. The state department of health shall
- 13 conduct a study of the implementation of Indian treaty rights relating to Indian health. The state
- 14 department of health shall report its findings and recommendations to the legislative council by
- 15 September 1, 2010.
- 16 SECTION 3. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO STUDY IMPLEMENTATION
- 17 **OF INDIAN TREATY RIGHTS RELATING TO WELFARE.** The department of human services
- 18 shall conduct a study of the implementation of Indian treaty rights relating to welfare. The
- 19 department of human services shall report its findings and recommendations to the legislative
- 20 council by September 1, 2010.
