- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 18-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to exemptions from the state fire code.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 18-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - **18-01-04.** Rules for prevention of fires to be issued. The state fire marshal, under the supervision of the attorney general, shall make rules not inconsistent with the provisions of this code for the prevention of fires and shall explain such the rules fully to all state, county, and municipal boards and officers. All such The rules must be posted in such conspicuous places as will tend to be of the greatest benefit to the residents of the state, and when called upon, the state fire marshal or one of the state fire marshal's assistants shall appear before any public board and explain the benefits derived from compliance with such the rules and regulations in
- 13 the reduction of hazardous conditions and loss by fire. The state fire marshal shall adopt rules
- to provide a procedure through which the state fire marshal may approve a request for an
- 15 exemption from the state fire code to allow the temporary occupancy of a structure that is a
- restoration or reconstruction of a historical structure. The rules must provide for fire safety 16
- 17 procedures and methods that are consistent with the historical nature of the structure.
