- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of a virtual university; to amend and reenact section
- 3 15-10-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to institutions administered by the state
- 4 board of higher education; to provide an appropriation; and to provide an effective date.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-10-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 15-10-01. State board of higher education Institutions administered by board.
- 9 The state board of higher education shall have the control and administration of the following
- 10 state educational institutions:
- 1. The state university and the school of mines at Grand Forks, with their substations-:
- 13 2. The North Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science and the 14 agricultural experiment station at Fargo, with their substations or centers-:

4	SEC	CTION 2. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5	created and	d enacted as follows:
6	<u>Nor</u>	th Dakota virtual university.
7	<u>1.</u>	Annually, each institution under the control of the state board of higher education
8		shall report to the board:
9		a. The actual number of students and the number of full-time equivalent
10		students enrolled in a virtual course; and
11		b. The name of the virtual course in which the students are enrolled.
12	<u>2.</u>	An institution is entitled to retain all tuition and fees associated with a student's
13		enrollment in a virtual course and any other income generated as a result of
14		offering the course.
15	<u>3.</u>	For purposes of reporting enrollment, an institution may not include the number of
16		full-time equivalent students enrolled in a virtual course.
17	<u>4.</u>	The board shall compile the information required by subsection 1 and shall report
18		the number of full-time equivalent students enrolled in at least one virtual course as
19		being enrolled in the North Dakota virtual university.
20	<u>5.</u>	For purposes of this section, a "virtual course" means any course other than one
21		offered through traditional inperson instruction and includes all courses offered
22		electronically and dual-credit courses.
23	SEC	CTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
24	general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much	
25	of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of	
26	assisting wi	th technology and other costs related to the establishment of the North Dakota
27	virtual unive	ersity, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective on July 1, 2010.
