4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - BLUE CROSS BLUE SHIELD OF

6 NORTH DAKOTA.

- During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall study blue cross blue shield
 of North Dakota to determine whether legislative changes are appropriate to the
 laws relating to nonprofit mutual insurance companies. The study must include a:
 a. Review of the legislative history of the 1997 legislation leading to conversion
 of blue cross blue shield of North Dakota from a nonprofit health service
 corporation to a nonprofit mutual insurance company;
- b. Consideration of whether the charitable trust and fiduciary duty of a nonprofit
 entity has remained throughout this conversion;
- 15 c. Consideration of whether it is desirable to amend the laws relating to the
 16 business structure, including wholly owned subsidiaries, of blue cross blue
 17 shield of North Dakota; and
- 18 d. Review of the process for approval of premium rates for a nonprofit mutual
 19 insurance company, including the history of escalating premiums and
 20 concerns relating to provider payment practices.
- The legislative council shall report its finding and recommendations, together with
 any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second
 legislative assembly.
