1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 40-23-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to exemption of cemetery property from special assessment; to provide a statement of

3 legislative intent; to provide an effective date; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 40-23-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 40-23-07. Determination of special assessments by commission - Political 8 subdivisions not exempt. Whenever the commission makes any special assessment, the 9 commission shall determine the particular lots and parcels of land which, in the opinion of the 10 commission, will be especially benefited by the construction of the work for which the 11 assessment is to be made. The commission shall determine the amount in which each of the 12 lots and parcels of land will be especially benefited by the construction of the work for which 13 such special assessment is to be made, and shall assess against each of such lots and parcels of land such sum, not exceeding the benefits, as shall be is necessary to pay its just proportion 14 15 of the total cost of such work, or of the part thereof which is to be paid by special assessment, 16 including all expenses incurred in making such assessment and publishing necessary notices 17 with reference thereto and the per diem of the commission. However, as an alternative to the 18 procedure heretofore provided in this section, the special assessment commission may, in its 19 discretion, determine and allocate the cost of special assessments in accordance with the 20 method provided for in chapter 40-23.1. Property owned by a nonprofit entity and used 21 exclusively as a cemetery is exempt from assessment or collection of special assessments for 22 benefits conferred under this chapter. Benefited property belonging to counties, cities, school 23 districts, park districts, and townships shall is not be exempt from such assessment, and such 24 public corporations whose property is so assessed shall provide for the payment of such

- 1 assessments, installments thereof and interest thereon, by the levy of taxes according to law.
- 2 Nothing in this section shall may be deemed to amend other provisions of law with reference to
- 3 the levy of assessments on property sold for delinquent taxes.

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the sixty-first legislative
assembly by enactment of this Act to confirm and continue the 1970 North Dakota supreme
court decision holding that special assessments upon the property of a cemetery owned by a
nonprofit corporation are void and that the supreme court decision has governed imposition of
special assessments, at a minimum, since the time of that decision.
SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for assessment or collection of

10 special assessments regardless of the date of the assessment.

11 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
