HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3004

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study Indian education issues. 2 WHEREAS, the rate of population growth on the state's Indian reservations is one of the 3 highest growth rates in the state; and 4 WHEREAS, a larger percentage of Indian youth remain in the state upon graduation 5 than do other youth; and 6 WHEREAS, a good quality education is essential for Indian youth to fully develop their 7 talents and contribute to the general welfare of the state of North Dakota; and 8 WHEREAS, many schools in Indian country are challenged by school finance issues; 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 10 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 11 That the Legislative Council study Indian education issues; and 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council assign this study to an 13 interim Education Committee or other similar interim committee for study; and 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 16 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
