- 2 Workforce Safety and Insurance and determine the feasibility and desirability of mutualization of
- 3 Workforce Safety and Insurance.
- 4 **WHEREAS**, during the 2007-08 interim, the Legislative Council studied Workforce
- 5 Safety and Insurance, including the governance of the agency; and
- 6 **WHEREAS**, the study by the Legislative Council included the receipt of testimony from
- 7 representatives of two states that have transformed monopolistic state workers' compensation
- 8 agencies into a mutual insurance company and moved to a competitive market; and
- 9 **WHEREAS**, changing the governance structure of Workforce Safety and Insurance
- 10 could lead to a more efficient and responsive workers' compensation system in this state;
 - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 12 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 13 That the Legislative Council study the governance structure of Workforce Safety and
- 14 Insurance and determine the feasibility and desirability of mutualization of Workforce Safety and
- 15 Insurance; and
