1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the governance structure of

2 Workforce Safety and Insurance and determine the feasibility and desirability of mutualization

3 or privatization of Workforce Safety and Insurance.

4 WHEREAS, during the 2007-08 interim, the Legislative Council studied Workforce

5 Safety and Insurance, including the governance of the agency; and

6 WHEREAS, the study by the Legislative Council included the receipt of testimony from

7 representatives of two states that have transformed monopolistic state workers' compensation

8 agencies into a mutual insurance company and moved to a competitive market; and

9 WHEREAS, changing the governance structure of Workforce Safety and Insurance
10 could lead to a more efficient and responsive workers' compensation system in this state;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

12 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

13 That the Legislative Council study the governance structure of Workforce Safety and

14 Insurance and determine the feasibility and desirability of mutualization or privatization of

15 Workforce Safety and Insurance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
