1 A concurrent resolution expressing support for the public awareness of multiple sclerosis and 2 urging the Congress of the United States to join in the movement in creating a world free of 3 multiple sclerosis. 4 WHEREAS, multiple sclerosis is a chronic and disabling disease of the central nervous 5 system in which the progression, severity, and specific symptoms cannot be foreseen; and 6 WHEREAS, every hour of every day someone new is diagnosed with multiple sclerosis, 7 a disease that can erode a person's abilities and hopes, halt a career, and unravel the fabric of 8 families; and 9 WHEREAS, last year in North Dakota more than \$700,000 was raised to find a cure for 10 multiple sclerosis and develop effective treatments for the disease, as well as to provide a wide 11 range of client programs to improve the lives of the 1,500 individuals living with multiple 12 sclerosis in our state; and 13 WHEREAS, this investment is paying off in significant advances in treating multiple 14 sclerosis, such as new medications that may reduce or delay future disability for people with 15 multiple sclerosis; and 16 WHEREAS, although research advances have brought us closer to finding the cure, 17 much remains to be done and services must continue to be provided to those who live with the 18 disease; and 19 WHEREAS, there are public and private agencies available to serve the constantly 20 changing needs of North Dakotans with multiple sclerosis and their families by extending 21 essential service to all who need them; 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
