1 A concurrent resolution urging Congress and the President to adopt a veterans remembered 2 flag. 3 WHEREAS, there are flags for all branches of the armed services and flags for 4 prisoners of war and individuals declared missing in action, but there is not a flag to honor the 5 millions of former military personnel who have served our nation; and 6 WHEREAS, it is estimated that 20,400,000 veterans have served in our nation's 7 military; and 8 WHEREAS, a veterans remembered flag would memorialize and honor all past, 9 present, and future veterans and would be a symbol of recognition for a group and an ideal; and 10 WHEREAS, displaying and flying this flag would validate the lives of millions of 11 individuals who have served our country in times of war, peace, and national crisis; and 12 WHEREAS, the symbolism of this unique flag's design would be all inclusive and would 13 pay respect to the history of our nation, to all branches of the military, and honor those who 14 have served or died in the service of our nation; and 15 WHEREAS, the proposed design of the veterans remembered flag would depict the 16 founding of our nation through 13 stars that emanate from the hoist of the flag and march to the 17 large red star that represents the nation and the five branches of our country's military; the 18 white star would indicate a veteran's dedication to service; the blue star would honor all men 19 and women who have ever served in the military; the gold star would memorialize those who 20 fell defending the nation; the blue stripe bearing the title of the flag would honor the loyalty of
