HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3035 Sixty-first

A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the Mill and Elevator
Association.
WHEREAS, North Dakota Century Code Chapter 54-18 provides for a state-owned Mill
and Elevator Association under the control of the Industrial Commission; and
WHEREAS, the Mill and Elevator Association began operating in October 1922; and
WHEREAS, the Mill and Elevator Association has contributed a share of its profits to the
general fund for over 35 years; and
WHEREAS, the Mill and Elevator Associations's value based on insured replacement
value is \$115,600,000; and
WHEREAS, alternatives may be available to increase the benefits of the Mill and
Elevator Association to agricultural producers and consumers in North Dakota;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
That the Legislative Council study the Mill and Elevator Association, including a
determination of its value and return on investment and options for increasing its value and
return on investment, and options for and feasibility of converting ownership of the mill to a
stock company directly owned by all North Dakota residents; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendation, to
the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
