HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3031

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study eminent domain laws as they 2 relate to pipeline siting. 3 WHEREAS, pipelines may be built across multiple states, including this state, without a 4 direct benefit to the people of this state; and 5 WHEREAS, the eminent domain laws of this state may be used against property 6 owners in this state to locate a pipeline on their property without their consent; and 7 WHEREAS, the property taken by eminent domain may be taken without consideration 8 for the surrounding property and future uses of the property; and 9 WHEREAS, the burden is on the property owner to defend against eminent domain for 10 which the property owner incurs legal fees and costs; 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 12 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 13 That the Legislative Council study eminent domain laws as they relate to pipeline siting; 14 and 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 17 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
