1 A concurrent resolution congratulating the Napoleon FFA team on its national championship.

5 **WHEREAS**, the National FFA Organization was founded in 1928 and has hosted 80
6 annual conventions; and

7 **WHEREAS**, since 1991 Napoleon High School has had 68 state champions and
8 championship teams; and

9 **WHEREAS**, at the 2008 National FFA Organization convention in Indianapolis, Indiana,
10 a team from Napoleon High School won first place in the Agricultural Sales Career
11 Development event; and

12 **WHEREAS**, this is the first national championship for Napoleon High School and the
13 first for this state; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the members of the championship team are Cole Laber, Andrew Young,
15 Alison Moser, and Morgan Schwanzenberger and the advisor is Mr. Brian Schneider;

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
