4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 43-41-02 of the North Dakota
 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- Nothing in this chapter prevents the employment of social work designees by
 hospitals, basic care facilities, or skilled nursing facilities, provided these persons
 <u>individuals</u> work under the direction of a social worker or social work consultant
 licensed under this chapter <u>and that the board be notified of the name of the</u>
- designee's employer and the name of the licensee who is providing direction or
 consultation to the designees.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 43-41-04 of the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 4. The board shall issue a license as a licensed independent clinical social worker toan applicant who:
- 17 a. Has a doctorate or master's degree in social work from a college or university.
- 18 b. Has passed an examination approved by the board for this purpose.
- 19c.Has satisfied the board that within a four-year period the applicant has20successfully completed within four years, three thousand hours of
- 21 post-master's clinical social work experience under the supervision of a
- 22 licensed certified social worker who has two years of experience, a licensed
- 23 independent clinical social worker, or, if an applicant began that supervised
- 24 <u>clinical social work experience before August 1, 2009, a licensed certified</u>

9	<u>a</u>	appointment, licensed social workers; one of whom must be, at the time of initial
