ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2080

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-20.4 of the North Dakota

- 2 Century Code, relating to the operation of accreditation mills; to amend and reenact section
- 3 15-20.4-02, subsection 3 of section 15-20.4-03, subsection 1 of section 15-20.4-04, section
- 4 15-20.4-06, and subsection 1 of section 15-20.4-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating
- 5 to authorizations to operate postsecondary educational institutions and false academic
- 6 degrees; to repeal section 15-20.4-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to negotiation
- 7 of promissory instruments by postsecondary educational institutions; and to provide a penalty.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

9 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-20.4-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
10 amended and reenacted as follows:

15-20.4-02. Exemptions. The following education and educational institutions are
 exempted from the provisions of this chapter:

- Institutions exclusively offering instruction at any or all levels from preschool
 through the twelfth grade.
- Education sponsored by a bona fide trade, business, professional, or fraternal
 organization, so recognized by the board, solely for that organization's
- 17 membership, or offered on a no-fee basis.
- Education solely avocational or recreational in nature, as determined by the board,
 and institutions offering such education exclusively.
- 20 4. Certain education provided through short-term programs as determined by the21 board.
- 5. Education offered by charitable institutions, organizations, or agencies, so
 recognized by the board, provided the education is not advertised or promoted as
 leading toward educational credentials.
