BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 27-09.1-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

 27-09.1-14. Mileage and compensation of jurors. A juror must be paid mileage at
- 8 rate of twenty five dollars for the first day and fifty dollars for each subsequent day of required

the rate provided for state employees in section 54-06-09. A juror must be compensated at the

- 9 attendance at sessions of the district court and <u>unless the juror is in attendance for four hours</u>
- 10 or less on the first day, in which case compensation for the first day is twenty-five dollars. A
- 11 juror must be compensated at the rate of ten dollars for each day of required attendance at
- 12 sessions of a coroner's inquest. The mileage and compensation of jurors must be paid by the
- 13 state for jurors at sessions of the district court. Jurors at coroner's inquests must be paid by the
- 14 county.
