- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-12-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to notice of increased assessment for property tax purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 57-12-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **57-12-09. Notice of increased assessment to real estate owner.** When any
- 7 assessor has increased the true and full valuation of any lot or tract of land or any
- 8 improvements thereon by three thousand dollars or more and to more than ten percent more
- 9 than the amount of the last assessment, notice of the amount of increase over the last
- 10 assessment and the amount of the last assessment must be delivered in writing by the
- 11 assessor to the property owner, mailed in writing to the property owner at the property owner's
- 12 last-known address, or provided to the property owner by electronic mail directed with
- 13 verification of receipt to an electronic mail address at which the property owner has consented
- 14 to receive notice. Delivery of notice to a property owner under this section must be completed
- 15 not fewer than fifteen days before the meeting of the local equalization board. The tax
- 16 commissioner shall prescribe suitable forms for this notice and the notice must show the true
- and full value as defined by law of the property, including improvements, that the assessor used
- 18 in making the assessment for the current year and for the year in which the last assessment
- 19 was made and must also show the date prescribed by law for the meeting of the local
- 20 equalization board of the assessment district in which the property is located and the meeting
- 21 date of the county equalization board. The notice must be mailed or delivered at the expense
- 22 of the assessment district for which the assessor is employed.
