**SENATE BILL NO. 2130**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 52-04-22 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the federal advance interest repayment fund; and to provide a continuing  
3 appropriation.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 52-04-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **52-04-22. Federal advance interest repayment fund - Continuing appropriation.**

8 There is created the federal advance interest repayment fund, to which will be credited all  
9 assessments collected by the division for the purpose of paying interest due on federal  
10 advances to the state trust fund. The fund must consist of all interest collected on delinquent  
11 contributions, all penalties provided by the North Dakota unemployment compensation law, and  
12 funds borrowed from sources other than federal advances which are placed in this fund. All  
13 moneys accruing to this fund in any manner must be maintained in this separate  
14 interest-bearing account at the Bank of North Dakota or invested in deposits of the Bank of  
15 North Dakota.

16 Moneys in this fund may also be used for the purpose of repaying funds placed in this  
17 fund which are borrowed from sources other than federal advances and for the purpose of  
18 paying interest due on other than federal advances. However, moneys in this fund may not be  
19 expended or available for expenditure in any manner which would permit their substitution for,  
20 or a corresponding reduction in, federal funds which would in the absence of the moneys be  
21 available to finance expenditures for the administration of the bureau.

22 Moneys in this fund may also be used for the purpose of paying principal and interest  
23 costs associated with the acquisition and renovation of land and a building to be used as an  
24 office facility by job service North Dakota in Grand Forks, North Dakota. Moneys in this fund

1 also may be used for the purpose of paying principal and interest costs associated with the  
2 acquisition and renovation of land and building to be used as an office facility by job service  
3 North Dakota in Bismarck, North Dakota. Moneys in this fund also may be used for the  
4 purpose of paying building lease costs of office facilities leased by job service North Dakota.  
5 Moneys in this fund may be used for the purpose of paying the costs of repair, renovation, or  
6 alteration of job service-owned office facilities. Moneys in this fund may be used for the  
7 purpose of paying the replacement rate charged for use of state fleet vehicles. Moneys in this  
8 fund may be used for the purposes of reemployment programs to ensure the integrity of the  
9 unemployment insurance program in this state. Moneys in this fund are hereby appropriated for  
10 the purposes specified in this section including the purpose of paying principal and interest  
11 costs associated with the acquisition and renovation of land and a building to be used as an  
12 office facility by job service North Dakota in Grand Forks, North Dakota. Moneys in this fund  
13 are appropriated for the purpose of paying the principal and interest costs associated with the  
14 acquisition and renovation of land and a building to be used as an office facility by job service  
15 North Dakota in Bismarck, North Dakota. Moneys in this fund are appropriated for the purpose  
16 of paying building lease costs of office facilities leased by job service North Dakota. Moneys in  
17 this fund are appropriated for the purpose of paying the costs of repair, renovation, or alteration  
18 of job service-owned office facilities. Moneys in this fund are appropriated for the purpose of  
19 paying the replacement rate charged for use of state fleet vehicles. Moneys in this fund are  
20 appropriated for the purposes of reemployment programs to ensure the integrity of the  
21 unemployment insurance program in this state.
